Developed by renowned educational psychologist **Professor Reuven Feuerstein**, the **Feuerstein Instrumental Enrichment Program (IE)** is a thinking skills enhancement program that offers a variety of teaching packages for different abilities and is suitable for all ages, from children to adults. It can be applied in the classroom, in small groups or in individual training. Using a unique guided approach, it is an intellectual and learning enhancement program for the general students, an enrichment program for the gifted, and a corrective training program for students with learning challenges.

The Feuerstein Approach

Teaching students how to think and learn

The Feuerstein Approach is a unique teaching method that focuses on the learning process and the mediation from the mediator. The mediator needs to analyse the needs of the students, select appropriate materials and teaching methods, with the aim of enabling students to develop thinking skills and trigger their hidden intelligence. For example, if a student has difficulties in mathematics, the mediator will first address the root causes and close the gap between thinking skills and performance so to improve performance in mathematics. Through this approach, students' attitudes to learning can be transformed from negative to positive!



IE Standard Program

The IE (Standard) Program is suitable for students aged above 8 and it consists of 14 instruments. Each focusing on a different cognitive strategy to help refine the development of concepts, introduce, teach and enhance cognitive functions. The training course is suitable for therapists, educational professionals, psychologists, parents and other related professionals.

Is there any research on IE?


