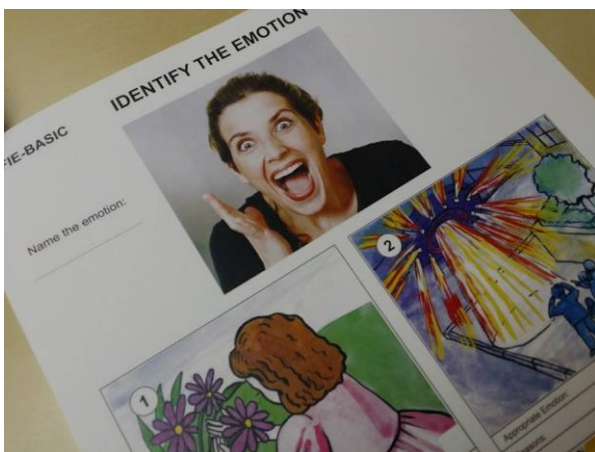
The Feuerstein Method

The Feuerstein Method is a unique educational technique developed by world-renowned psychologist **Reuven Feuerstein**. It is a process-based approach, focusing on developing the vitally important – and often overlooked – skill of learning how to learn, subsequently tapping into an individual's latent intellectual capabilities.

Feuerstein Early Childhood Program

Feuerstein's Early Childhood Curriculum is the essential blueprint for early childhood and elementary school education. It creates systematic, persistent and structured conditions to engage young children in problem solving. It is distinct in that it develops children's fundamental cognitive and learning skills as well as their emotional abilities. It provides young children with the tools to help them become considerate friends and contributing members of society.



IE Basic Program

An important component of Feuerstein's Early Childhood Curriculum is the IE Basic program. Consisting of eleven instruments or 'tools,' IE Basic is a series of activities that may be mediated in a classroom, group or individual setting. Each instrument focuses on a different cognitive strategy, helping to develop the children's general basic concepts, emerging cognitive functions (such as self-regulation, generalization, and conceptualization) and intrinsic motivation.

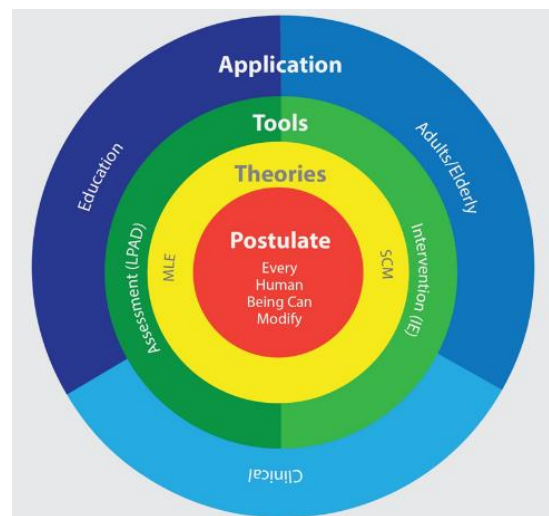
What is it?

IE Basic-2 is the second among the two modules of the IE Basic Program. It is intended for educators, psychologists, speech therapists, clinicians, child care workers, parents and other professional working with younger children. It is a cognitive intervention program which can be applied in a one-on-one setting or in the classroom. For individuals with special needs, IE is used as a remediation program while higher functioning learner utilize it as an enrichment tool. The skills and content are also applicable to elderly remediation.

Is there any certification for the course?

Yes. Full attendance of training activities is required.
